Secondly, this transition would have been impossible without the tremendous effort by the HR/Admin Team. They have played a stellar role in setting and managing expectations, brought on by this new mode of operating, both with existing team members and potential employees. As the first and primary ambassadors of the WFH culture, the HR team has bought in exiting and engaging activities, such as, Coffees & Chit Chats, Fundoo Friday Games and Town Halls – all conducted via virtual mode, keeping motivation levels charged and everyone in high spirits!
