In today's mobile-centric world, Android and iOS dominate the landscape, requiring distinct skill sets in Kotlin, Java, Objective C, or Swift. However, managing separate codebases for these platforms proves cumbersome and costly for developers. To streamline this process, cross-platform technologies like Flutter and React Native have emerged.

1. Flutter: Flutter, Google's open-source UI toolkit, debuted in 2015 under the project name "Sky." It aimed to streamline natively compiled app development for mobile, web, and desktop from a unified codebase. The first stable version, Flutter 1.0, launched in December 2018, emphasizing a rapid development cycle and hot-reload feature. Powered by the Dart programming language, Flutter prioritizes performance and productivity. Developers leverage Dart to create seamless cross-platform experiences for mobile, web, and desktop applications.

Key releases for Flutter include:

- 1. Flutter 1.0 (December 4, 2018) First stable version, ready for production use.
- 2. Flutter 1.2 (February 14, 2019) Introduced web-based tools for creating web applications in Flutter.
- 3. Flutter 1.12 (December 11, 2019) Enhanced with Android App Bundles support, improved performance, and additional Dart extensions.
- 4. Flutter 2.0 (March 3, 2021) Major release with stable web support, alpha-stage desktop support, and enhanced performance.
- 5. Flutter 2.5 (August 10, 2021) Introduces features like Material You, focusing on improving mobile and web development experiences.

2. React Native: React Native, created by Facebook and released in 2015, is a renowned open-source framework for mobile app development. Its global availability since March 2015 attracted developers due to its performance and component reusability across diverse platforms. In 2017, the Expo framework further simplified React Native development by offering tools not just for iOS and Android but also for web and other platforms.

Key releases in the React Native journey include:

- 1. React Native 0.1 (January 26, 2015) The first public release of React Native.
- 2. React Native 0.18 (February 22, 2016) The first version with support for Android.
- 3. React Native 0.59 (March 12, 2019) Introduced React Hooks and a new React Navigation library.
- 4. **React Native 0.60 (July 3, 2019)** Brought significant performance improvements and Auto-Linking for native modules.
- 5. **React Native 0.64 (March 2021)** Added Hermes 0.6.0, a new version of the JavaScript engine, and support for the Hermes Bytecode.
- 6. React Native 0.65(August 2021) Included support for Apple Silicon (M1) and AndroidX by default.

Flutter and React Native is under active development, and new releases and updates continue to be released regularly.
